Permafrost investigations in the highest mountains of Bulgaria and Romanian Carpathians (Romania)

Information on permafrost conditions in the Balkan Peninsula highest mountains is limited. In the Romanian Carpathians the presence of permafrost was documented by various studies in the last years. In marginal periglacial mountain regions, such as the Carpathians Mountains, the distribution of permafrost is strongly controlled by complex local topo-climatic factors. Isolated patches of permafrost may occur above 2000 m in the highest mountain ranges in the Romanian Carpathians (e.g., Retezat, Parâng and Făgăraș Mountains). The distribution and characteristics of mountain permafrost in the Romanian Carpathians were examined using a combined approach consisting in thermal monitoring and geophysical investigations. A similar approach was used in the last three years in case of several rock glaciers in the Rila and Pirin Mountains to investigate permafrost conditions. The results indicate that ice-rich frozen debris are expected to occur in north-

facing rock glaciers in the Rila and Pirin Mountains, above 2400 m. These findings were compared with the results reported for the rock glaciers in the Romanian Carpathians and confirmed that the characteristics of permafrost conditions in both regions are similar.
